A Grand Parade

News was carried in the July 2, 1888 issue of the Richfield Springs Daily of how the fireman honored one of Richfield's hotel owners with a parade.

"An abundance of good feeling was engendered Saturday evening by the give and return of compliments between the fire department and Mr. Eugene Earle of the New American. It was designed to compliment Mr. Earle with their presence on opening but by request, the act was put over until Saturday night which was the occasion of the grand opening of the hotel after many renovations.

The line was formed with the Burlington Flats Cornet Band immediately followed by Chief Cary and Assistant, L. McCredy. This division of the procession was followed by Hose Co. No. 2 which was out in full number, every man being present. Their cart was beautifully decorated with flags and evergreens. The line was concluded by the Hook and Ladder Company which was represented by a large portion of its members. They too, had a fine display of decorations on their cart and, under the glowing light of the most brilliant electricity, the procession presented an appearance which, to say was grand, would only approximate the idea an appreciative mind would desire to express.

The line of march was down James Street to Elm, to Main, up past and return to the New American, where a halt was ordered and the boys were welcomed by Mr. Earle in a few words which betrayed the generous and hearty good feeling he felt toward them and an invitation was extended to them to repair to the café to partake of the hospitality of the house.

They passed into the front entrance and down the grand hall where, a few steps below, was in waiting a choice lot of delicacies which were partaken of with profoundest good will toward the giver.

T. R. Proctor's appearance in the midst of the company added new life and someone moved 'three cheers' for the father of Richfield, which were given with marked enthusiasm. Mr. Proctor responded briefly, but with an earnestness that told the boys that in him they had a friend for all time. After leaving the New American, the program assumed a series of complimentary serenades. The leading hotels were favored with music and cheers and the reception of the firemen and band was most hearty throughout the evening. A large number of people were in town and the streets thronged, making a gala night of it."

The occasion was the culmination of the renewal of the New American which had been partially destroyed by fire in 1850 when it was known as the American, built by C. M. Paul. In 1851 it was rebuilt by General William Johnson. When Gen. Johnson died, the hotel was run by his heirs until 1881 when it was sold to Uriah Welch and renamed the New American. After 1888 when the property was purchased by Eugene M. Earle, it was renamed the Earlington and remained under that name until 1915 when Allen Bloomfield took possession and renamed it Bloomfield's. The hotel was located on the south side of east main street, across from Spring Park and taken down in 1943.

The description of some of the work involved in the transformation included: "A much needed fresh coat of paint of chrome yellow and maroon was given. The entrance by way of the veranda was ornamented on either side by two majestic palms. The front lawn was greatly improved, now being smooth as velvet. The vases were filled with beautiful flowers. The office and reading room showed an improved appearance. The walls were newly decorated in exquisite designs, new furniture arranged in a charming manner and elegant paintings graced the walls. These elegant paintings are said to have an aggregate value of about \$15,000. (Remember - this was in 1888).

The ladies' reception room is a perfect gem of refined taste. The rare cabinets filled with bric-a-brac, the luxuriant divans, the odd and cozy chairs nonchalantly placed here and there wait temptingly for someone to occupy them. The beautiful rugs strewn about and the faint light from the burning log on the pretty hearth makes the room extremely beautiful. The broad hallway was never so alluring as now. An old spinning wheel is standing beside the fireplace.

The parlors are being entirely refurnished and will be beautiful. The dining hall will be more attractive than ever. It is the finest room of the kind in town and the cuisine will be perfect in every particular. It can seat four hundred persons and lighted by numerous windows which makes it always cool. The private suites upon the main floor have also been greatly improved and the sleeping apartments throughout the house have been very thoroughly renovated being well ventilated and supplied with every convenience for comfort, lighted by electricity and supplied with electric bells. The new electric light system sheds a beautiful light and greatly adds to the already enchanting scene. Mr. and Mrs. Earle are to be congratulated on their success in making such an attractive place for their summer guests."

Mr. Eugene Mortimer Earle was generally described as tall with a handsome face, eyes in which humor and good nature showed and a mouth that was quick to smile. His ancestors had reputations as the proprietors of some of the best hotels in the United States. Being born in his father's hotel in New York City, he learned the hotel business as he grew and knew the service required for the pleasure, comfort and entertainment of refined visitors accustomed to the better things in life. He owned the Earlington until 1907, when it was sold to Frank Blackman who ran it until 1915. He occasionally came to Richfield for a summer visit a few times thereafter. He died in 1924.

Value Report,¹¹ a minor kitchen remodel provides a 96 percent ROI. A major kitchen remodel mid-range (49 percent) and a major kitchen remodel upscale (38 percent) did not provide as notable a ROI.

3. Expect the project to take some time. Kitchens are large rooms with a lot of components, so renovating these spaces can take some time. Estimates vary depending on the size of the room, the scale of the remodel and the materials chosen, but Angi reports a kitchen remodel for most homes takes six weeks to four months. That's a sizable window, and it reflects the likelihood that unforeseen issues like supply chain interruptions or the discovery of mold will arise at some point during the renovation. Though it's impossible to determine precisely how long a project will take before it begins, homeowners renovating their kitchens may want to plan for the project to take two months if not longer.

4. Expect to use your kitchen during the renovation. If the timeline of a renovation is scary, homeowners should know they will likely be able to use their kitchen even after the project begins. Though the room might not remain a popular gathering space once the work starts, Angi notes kitchens are typically out of commission for around six weeks during a renovation. That still requires some pre-planning in relation to meals, but it also suggests homeowners won't be without a kitchen for months on end.

been stuck in neutral and no sudden windfall of free time is on the horizon, start contacting contractors to finish the job for you.

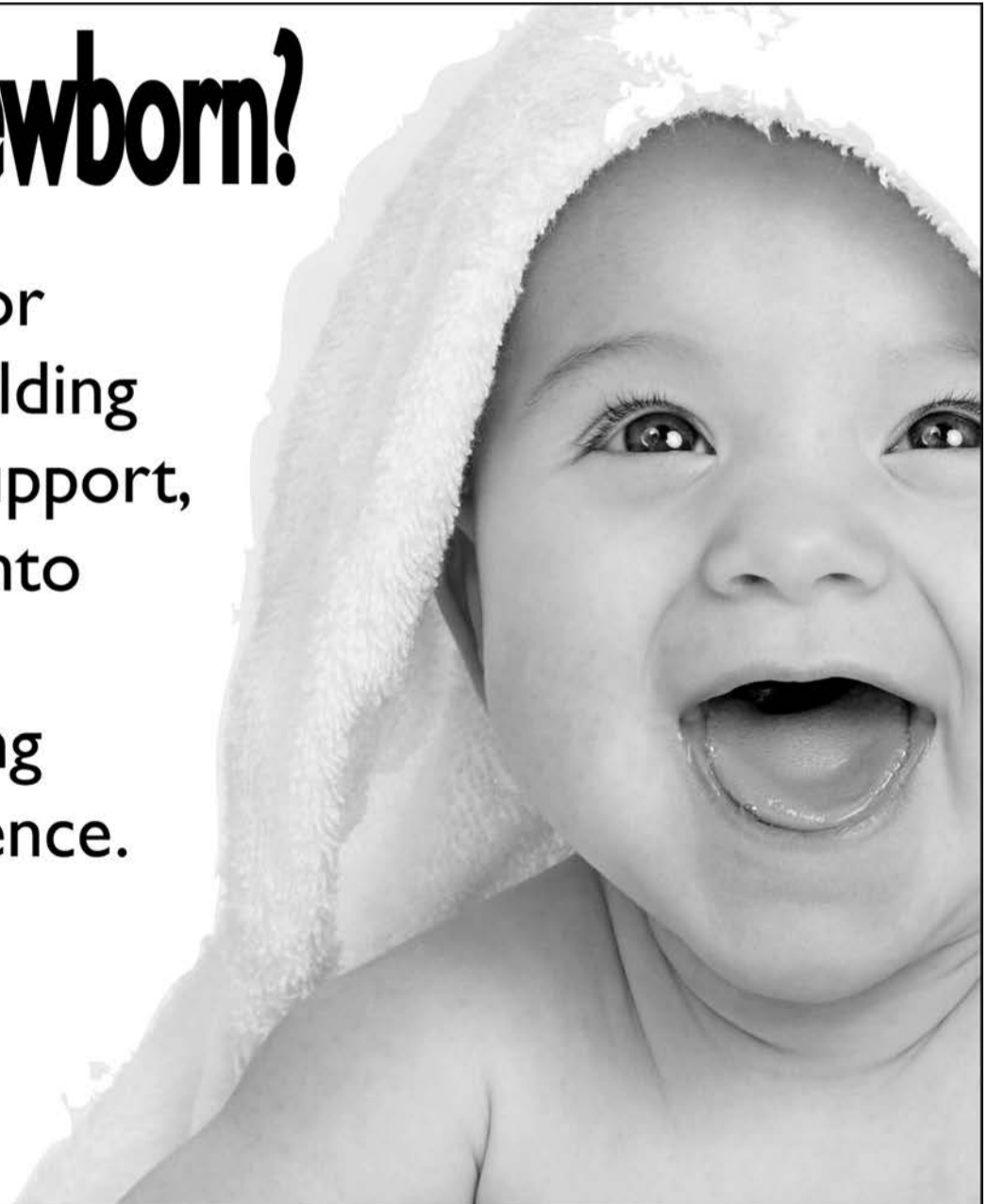
